

Dental Work After A Joint Replacement

If you have had a total or partial joint replacement surgery and you have a dental appointment scheduled, you will need to ***call our office at least 24 hours prior to your dental appointment so we can start you on an antibiotic.***

Dental Cleaning:

Begin taking the antibiotic 24 hours prior to the cleaning and continue for 2 days until gone.

Dental Extractions:

Begin taking the antibiotic 24 hours prior to extraction and continue until tooth socket is healed with a minimum of 5 days following procedure.
